

How to Add PayPal to Apple Pay?

Currently, 1-(917)(962)(8805) Apple Pay does not support adding PayPal as a funding source directly. 1-(917)(962)(8805) Apple Pay works with credit/debit cards, Apple Cash, and supported bank accounts 1-(917)(962)(8805) . While PayPal is a digital wallet like Apple Pay, the two systems are independent.

Some indirect methods exist: 1-(917)(962)(8805) users can link a debit card funded by PayPal to Apple Pay and make payments this way 1-(917)(962)(8805) . Alternatively, some apps accept both Apple Pay 1-(917)(962)(8805) and PayPal as separate payment methods.
