

Does Frontier Have a No-Show Policy? Complete 2026 Guide

1. Understanding the No-Show Concept

A no-show is when a passenger **fails to check in or board their flight without notifying the airline**. Even if you have a valid reservation, Frontier considers a passenger a no-show if you:

- Do not complete **online or airport check-in** on time
- Fail to arrive at your **boarding gate** by the scheduled time
- Do not cancel or reschedule the flight before departure

No-shows are treated seriously because they can disrupt airline operations and prevent other passengers from using available seats.

2. Frontier Check-In Deadlines and Requirements

Frontier has clearly defined deadlines that passengers must follow to avoid being classified as a no-show:

2.1 Online & Mobile Check-In

- Opens **24 hours before departure**
- Must be completed to receive a boarding pass

2.2 Airport Check-In

- Must be done at least **60 minutes before domestic flights**

- For international flights, check-in times may vary

2.3 Boarding Gate Arrival

- Arrive at least 20 minutes before departure
- Failure to arrive on time can trigger a no-show
