

1. The Standard Booking Window How Far in Advance Can I Book a Flight on Frontier Airlines?

As of January 2026, Frontier's flight schedule typically extends through **late summer/early fall (August or September 2026)**.

- **Average Window:** Frontier generally releases flights in "batches." You can usually book between **120 and 270 days** in advance.
- **Batch Releases:** Instead of adding one day at a time, Frontier often releases 2–3 months of flights at once. This usually happens every few months.

2. The GoWild! Pass Exception

Trip Type	Standard Booking Window	GoWild! Pass Window
Domestic Flights	4–9 Months	1 Day before departure
International Flights	4–9 Months	10 Days before departure

- **Early Booking Feature:** In 2026, Frontier allows pass holders to "lock in" certain flights further in advance for a small early-booking fee.
- **Blackout Dates:** Remember that GoWild! bookings are subject to blackout dates (e.g., around holiday weekends). To check if your desired date is blacked out, call = +1 ☎ (US) or ☎ [ {1 877_622_0707}] (USA) or ☎ {1 877_622_0707} (USA) ☎ (US).

3. When is the Best Time to Book?

In the world of ultra-low-cost carriers, the "early bird" doesn't always get the lowest fare, but they do get the best choice of seats and bag prices.

- **The "Sweet Spot":** For domestic flights, the best prices usually appear **1–3 months** before departure.
- **New Route Launches:** Frontier frequently announces new cities with "Introductory Fares" as low as \$19. These are usually announced 3–4 months before the first flight.
- **The 60-Day Rule:** Booking at least 60 days in advance is highly recommended because Frontier's **change fees** are **\$0** if you modify your trip more than 60 days before takeoff.

🛠 4. How to Book for Dates Not Yet Released

If your travel date (e.g., December 2026) is not yet on the website, follow these steps:

1. **Sign up for "The Loop":** Frontier's email newsletter is the first place schedule extensions are announced.
2. **Monitor Hubs:** Schedule extensions often hit major hubs (DEN, MCO, LAS) a few days before smaller regional airports.
3. **Use the Agent Line:** Sometimes, flights are loaded into the global distribution system (GDS) used by agents before they appear on the consumer website. Check with an agent at = +1 ☎ (US) or ✆ {1 877_622_0707 } (USA) or ☎ {1 877_622_0707 } (USA) ✆ (US).
