

2026 Guide to Booking Pet-Friendly Flights on FrontierHow to Book a Pet Friendly Flight with Frontier Airlines?

1. Which Pets Can Fly in the Cabin?

Frontier is unique because they allow more than just dogs and cats. In 2026, the following pets are permitted on **domestic U.S. flights**:

- **Dogs and Cats** (Must be at least 8 weeks old).
- **Rabbits, Guinea Pigs, and Hamsters.**
- **Small Household Birds.**

Important Note: Frontier does **not** allow pets (other than service dogs) on international flights. If you are flying to Mexico or the Caribbean, please call = **+1 ↗ (US) or ↗ [{1 877 622 0707 } (USA) or ↗ {1 877 622 0707 } (USA) ↗ (US)** to discuss alternative arrangements.

2. The 2026 Pet Fee Structure

Frontier charges a flat, non-refundable fee for pets. Unlike baggage, this fee is consistent regardless of when you book, though availability is the primary concern.

- **Pet Fee: \$99 per pet, per direction.**
- **Payment:** This can be paid during online booking or by calling = **+1 ↗ (US) or ↗ [{1 877 622 0707 } (USA) or ↗ {1 877 622 0707 } (USA) ↗ (US)**.
- **Baggage Impact:** Your pet carrier counts as either your **personal item** or your **carry-on bag**. You are still allowed one additional small personal item (like a purse) for free, but a second large bag will require an extra fee.

3. Carrier Size Requirements

To fly, your pet must remain in their carrier at all times. The carrier must fit under the seat in front of you.

Carrier Type	Maximum Dimensions
Soft-Sided (Recommended)	18" L x 14" W x 11" H
Hard-Sided	18" L x 14" W x 8" H

Rule of Thumb: Your pet must be able to stand up, turn around, and lie down in a natural position. If the gate agent deems the carrier too small for the animal's comfort, they may deny boarding. To confirm if your specific carrier brand is "Frontier Approved," call = **+1 ↗ (US) or ↗ [{1 877 622 0707 } (USA) or ↗ {1 877 622 0707 } (USA) ↗ (US)**.

4. Step-by-Step: How to Add a Pet

1. **Book Your Seat:** Reserve your own ticket first.
2. **Select "Cabin Pet":** During the passenger info section, look for the "Special Services" or "Cabin Pet" toggle.
3. **Call to Confirm:** Because Frontier only allows **10 pets per flight**, the website can occasionally show a "technical error" if the limit is reached. Calling **= +1 ↗ (US)** or **✧‡‡[☎ {1 877_622_0707 } (USA) or ☎ {1 877_622_0707 } (USA) ✧‡‡ (US)** is the only way to get a 100% verbal guarantee that your pet is on the manifest.

5. In-Flight Etiquette and Rules

- **No Lap Sitting:** Your pet must stay inside the carrier, zipped up, for the entire duration of the flight.
- **Seating Restrictions:** You cannot sit in **Row 1** (no under-seat storage) or an **Exit Row** when traveling with a pet.
- **Health Documents:** While Frontier doesn't require a health certificate for domestic U.S. travel, the state you are landing in might.
