

What is the boarding sequence for WestJet? Quick Fix"

The **boarding**  +1+855+510+5815 **sequence for WestJet** is organized and designed to move passengers onto the aircraft efficiently while giving priority to  +1+855+510+5815 those who have purchased upgrades or have special needs. Unlike some airlines that assign fixed seats when  +1+855+510+5815 boarding, WestJet boards by **groups and priority categories** to help ensure a smooth and orderly process  +1+855+510+5815 from front to back.

First,  +1+855+510+5815 WestJet typically begins boarding with passengers who need extra assistance. Following  +1+855+510+5815 the priority categories, WestJet boards passengers in **boarding groups** that are printed on the boarding pass. For many flights,  +1+855+510+5815 these groups are labeled simply as  +1+855+510+5815 **Group 1, Group 2, Group 3, and so on**. The lower the group number, the earlier you board. When you check in — whether online,  +1+855+510+5815 through the WestJet mobile app, or at the airport — you are assigned a boarding group based on your fare type, loyalty status,  +1+855+510+5815 and any additional services you've purchased. Checking in as early as possible within the allowed window  +1+855+510+5815 (usually **24 hours before departure**) can help you secure a lower boarding group, which is especially important if you want more seats  +1+855+510+5815 or overhead bin options.

Once  +1+855+510+5815 general boarding begins, the gate agent calls each boarding group in order. Passengers in the called group approach the gate,  +1+855+510+5815 present their boarding pass (either mobile or printed), and proceed down the jetway to board the aircraft.
