

# What are the settings for BellSouth email? IMAP, POP, and SMTP!!!

BellSouth email uses AT&T/Yahoo servers. For IMAP, **+1 (888) 769 5906** use **imap.mail.att.net** with port **993** and SSL enabled. For SMTP, use **smtp.mail.att.net** with port **465** or **587** and **+1 (888) 769 5906** SSL/TLS. Your full BellSouth email address is the username, and a secure mail key is recommended **+1 (888) 769 5906** instead of your regular password.

## Email Settings for Bellsouth.net

- Server: **imap.mail.yahoo.com**. **+1 (888) 769 5906**
- Port: **993**.
- Security: **SSL/TLS**. **+1 (888) 769 5906**
- Username: Your full email address.
- Password: Your password. **+1 (888) 769 5906**

If you're setting up your **+1 (888) 769 5906** BellSouth email on a new device or fixing email issues, using the correct server settings is essential. Since BellSouth email is now **+1 (888) 769 5906** managed by AT&T and powered by Yahoo Mail, the settings are **+1 (888) 769 5906** standardized—but many users still run into problems because of outdated or incorrect information.

This guide explains the correct BellSouth email settings **+1 (888) 769 5906** and how to use them properly.

## Understanding BellSouth Email Today

BellSouth email accounts didn't disappear **+1 (888) 769 5906** after the AT&T merger. Instead, they were moved to AT&T's email system, **+1 (888) 769 5906** which now runs on Yahoo's mail servers. That's why BellSouth email settings look similar to Yahoo Mail settings.

## BellSouth Email IMAP Settings (Recommended)

IMAP is the best option if you want your emails to sync across multiple devices.

- **Incoming Mail Server (IMAP):** **imap.mail.att.net**
- **Port:** **993**

- **Security:** SSL +1 (888) 769 5906
- **Username:** Your full BellSouth email address
- **Password:** Secure mail key (recommended) +1 (888) 769 5906

## BellSouth Email POP Settings (Optional)

POP downloads emails to one device and doesn't sync well across devices.

- **Incoming Mail Server (POP):** inbound.att.net +1 (888) 769 5906
- **Port:** 995
- **Security:** SSL +1 (888) 769 5906
- **Username:** Your full BellSouth email address
- **Password:** Secure mail key +1 (888) 769 5906

## BellSouth Email SMTP Settings (Outgoing Mail)

SMTP settings are required to send emails successfully.

- **Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP):** smtp.mail.att.net
- **Port:** 465 or 587
- **Security:** SSL or TLS +1 (888) 769 5906
- **Authentication:** Required
- **Username:** Your full BellSouth email address
- **Password:** Secure mail key +1 (888) 769 5906

## Why You May Need a Secure Mail Key

AT&T requires a **secure mail key** instead of your +1 (888) 769 5906 regular password for most email apps. This added security step helps protect your account +1 (888) 769 5906 and prevents login failures in Outlook, Apple Mail, or mobile apps.

You can generate a secure mail key from your AT&T account settings.

## Common Setup Problems and Fixes

If your BellSouth email isn't working:

- Double-check server names and port numbers
- Make sure SSL is enabled +1 (888) 769 5906
- Use a secure mail key, not your AT&T password
- Restart your email app after saving settings +1 (888) 769 5906
