Why Reboot Hulu?

1. Close and Reopen the Hulu App

- The fastest fix is to close >  +1-(866)-927-4470 Hulu and open it again.
- How to do it:
 - Press the Home or Back button on your remote.
 - Make sure the Hulu app >  +1-(866)-927-4470 fully closes.
 - Go to your Apps menu and open Hulu again.

2. Restart Your TV

If closing the app didn't help, restarting your TV usually >☎ +1-(866)-927-4470 does the trick. Try this: Turn your TV off.

- Plug it back in and turn the TV on.

3. Force Stop Hulu (For Android/Google TVs)

4. Clear the Hulu App Cache

- If your TV supports this:
- Open Settings → Apps.
- Select Hulu.
- Tap Clear Cache.
- (Don't worry—this won't delete your account.)

5. Reinstall the Hulu App

If nothing else works, reinstalling >☎ +1-(866)-927-4470 Hulu gives you a fresh start.

How to reinstall:

- Go to your TV's App Store ➤  +1-(866)-927-4470 or Apps section.
- Find Hulu.
- Select Uninstall.
- Install Hulu again.
